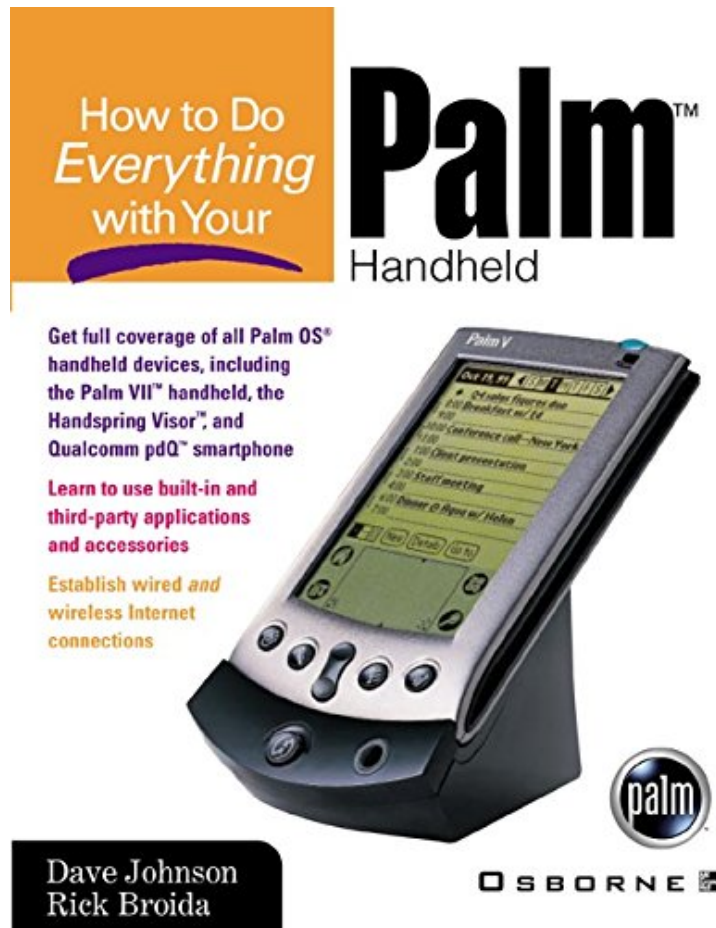

Both programs build tables based on to-do list data. Palm handhelds also come with an applet called Sun Compass, which could come in handy when you're on the road. Given that so many people use their PalmPilots as glorified address books, the tips Johnson and Broida supply are highly useful.
