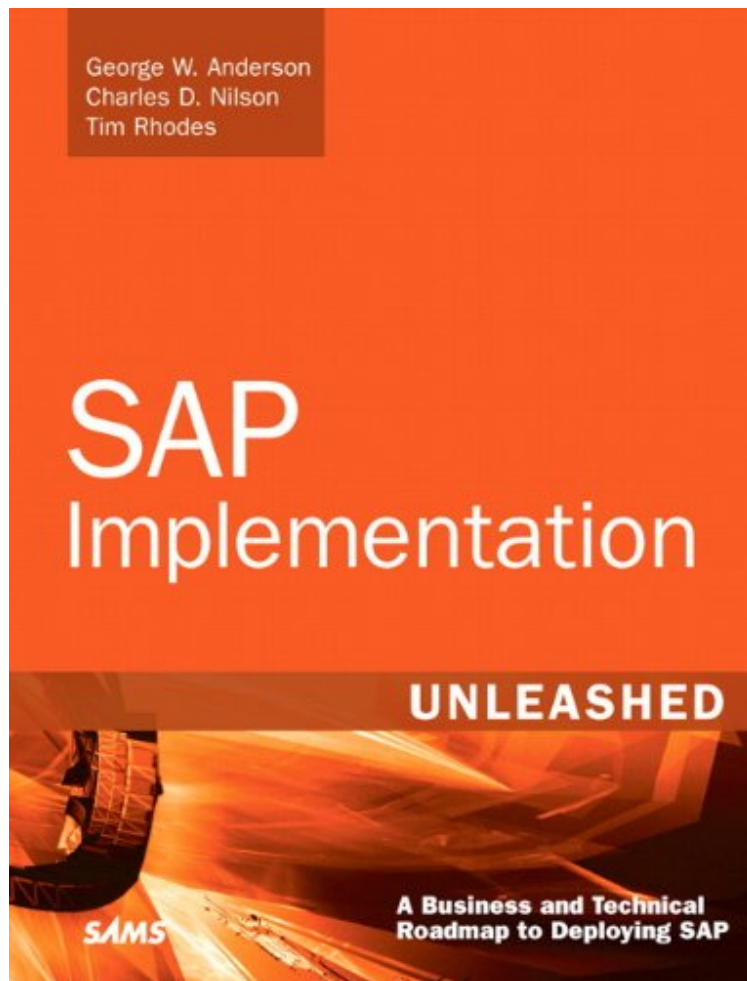

From this point of view it is a 5 star book. But it is a 1-2 star book if it comes to content of the topics. Here the authors leave you alone and mention only some well-

known phrases. For example: one of the most important things in large SAP implementation projects is change management, especially training. It is difficult to set up a concept for both if you've never had done this before or have no mentor to assist and guide you. But there's no help in the book - just a short abstract of a couple of lines. Also the book seems to serve both parties business consultants/project manager and technology consultants - it tries to deal with business blueprint topics and with high-availability or other topics regarding designing and setting up SAP landscapes on the same level of detail - which is only a rough one.
