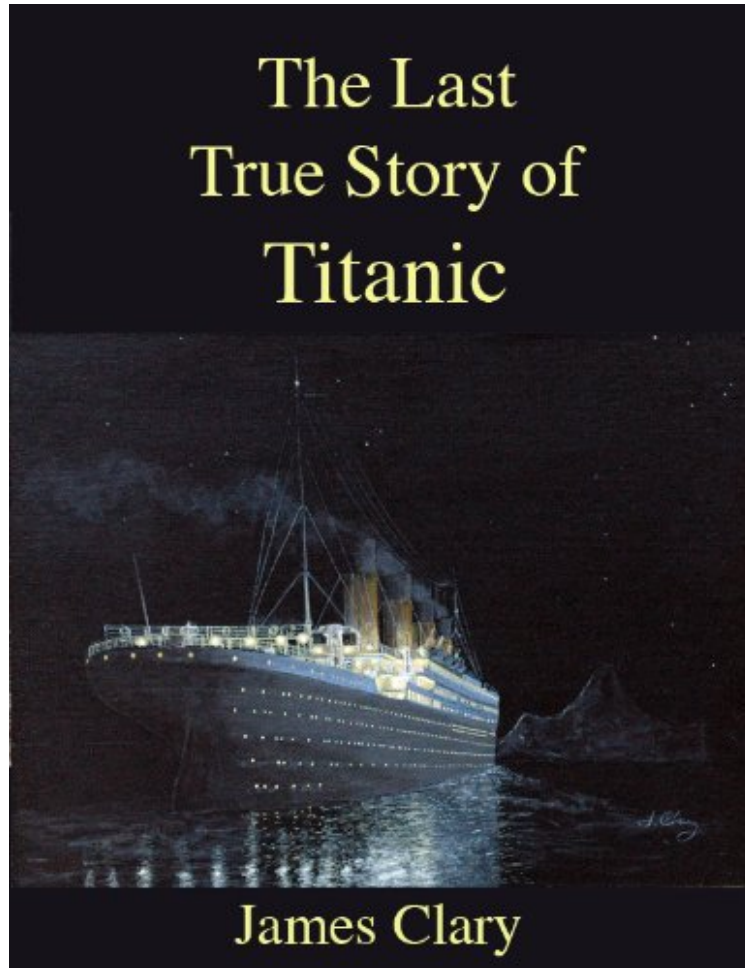

With a hole in the bow as well as along the side, the forward motion of the ship acted to virtually plow water into the ship thereby exacerbating flooding. However, had the ship stayed motionless in the water after the collision there may have been enough time for the Carpathia to arrive and save some of the people in the water.
