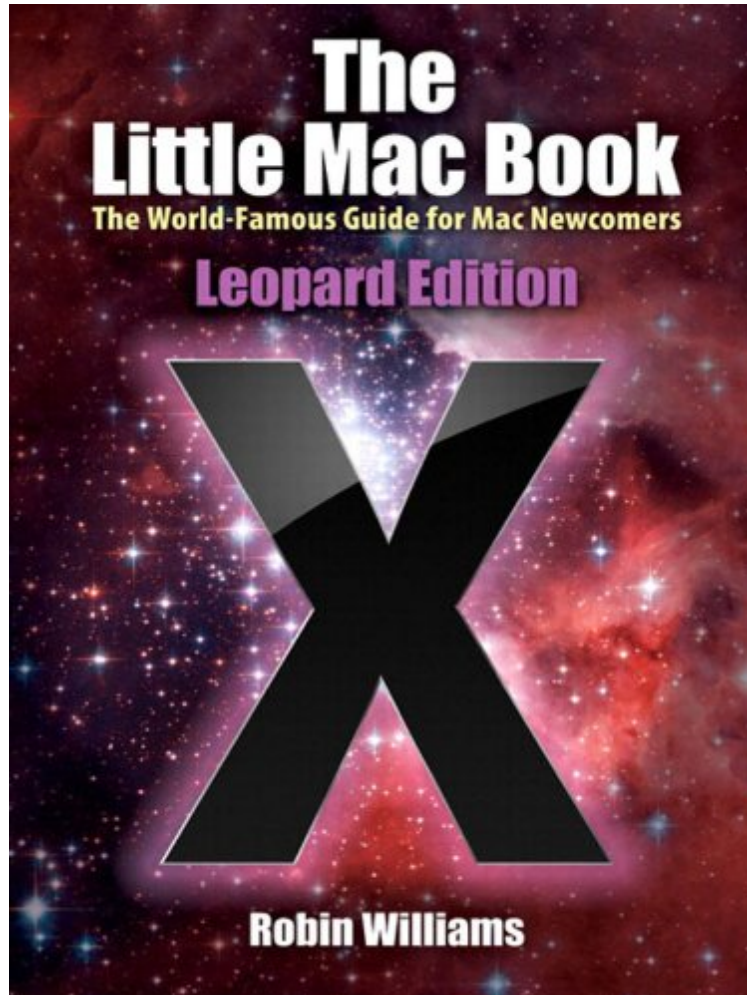

The level is very low, e.g. it explains on 12 pages (keeping in mind the book has only about 190 pages) how to click and drag the mouse (single-click; double-click; press; press-and-drag).
