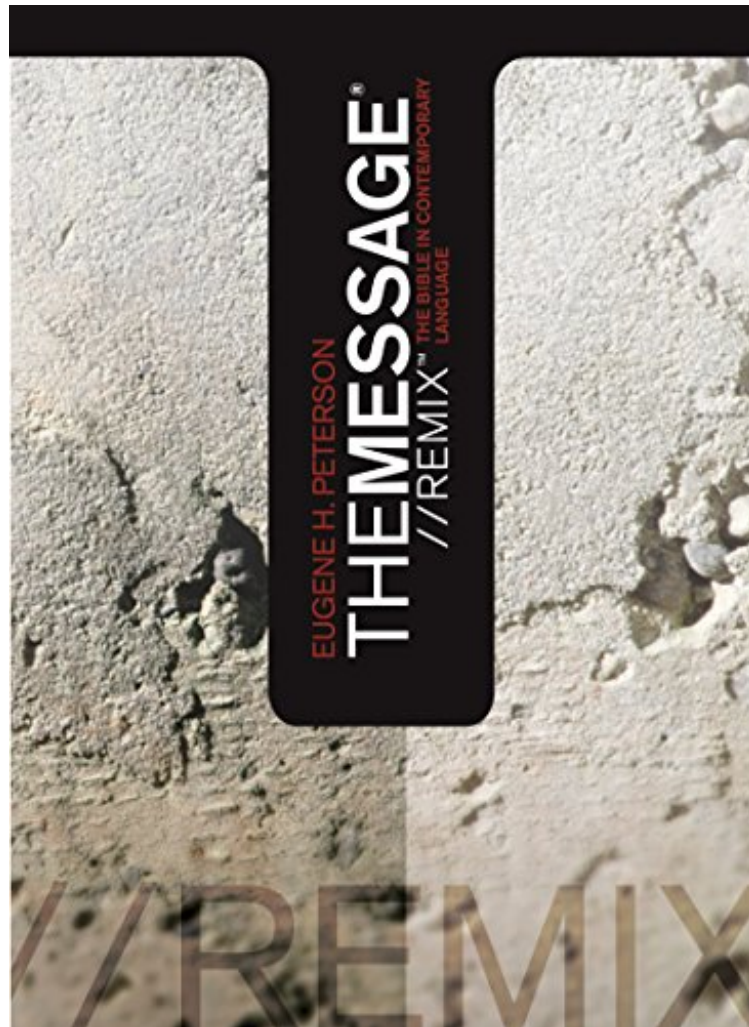

The Message Bible to me is one of the most comprehensive, mind-blowing and up-to-date bible translations (even for me as a German native speaker and highly intensive bible consumer). There are lots of printed editions in mostly good quality, and two different audio book versions. You can't really do wrong buying any edition, but for a good choice, you should know about some specialties of the content and the editions, too. It's worthwhile. See below. Full review: Author Content: I love reading the Bible and finding new colors by reading English translations even though my mother tongue is German and I have read through many of the German translations. I learned to appreciate the clarity of the NLT and the olden beauty of King James Version (and I also tried ESV and NIV). But my first encounter with The Message was overwhelming: Never in my life I read such a lively, transparent, intelligible and though fully authentic translation! There are unique Intros to every book: Peterson briefly explains the focus of every biblical book at the beginning, opening one's mind for aspects you might never have discovered, and at the same time making you keen to go on and start reading that Bible book yourself. Only one disadvantage for a German like me: You need to be comfortable with reading in English language and even then might need a dictionary for this rich treasury of words - even though you will not find ancient language here. Peterson may be a child of the 1930's, but he is quite a contemporary writer. Eugene H. Peterson is renowned in the US as theologian and writer, and The Message Bible has won the "2006 Christian Book Award". Audio books: There are two audio book editions of The Message Bible. As for any audio book, the reader and audio background is nearly as important as the content. Edition with the voice of Kerry Ryan Dolan. I bought the NT edition some time ago but the reading is so monotonous that I could actually not bear listening through it. The advantage of this edition is that you have the same voice all through. Edition with the voices of Christian singers: Toby Mac, Stephen Curtis Chapman, Rebecca St. James, and others from Third Day, Ceadmon's Call, Audioadrenaline, Avalon, Jars of Clay and others. Alone the fact that these wanted to lend their voices does say something about the content. I listened briefly into a sample and I found it not monotonous at all but so to say at the other end of the scale: Listening to Rebecca St James as she reads through Ephesians chapter 1 is somehow ... strenuous, as a rabbi once phrased it: Like an instrument tuned up a bit too high. But still, I personally would prefer this one to the one of Kerry Ryan Dolan. Text layout: Concerning the text layout, please be aware that the Message Bible is not a verse-by-verse translation, so there are unnumbered editions. If you prefer a numbered edition, check if it is tagged as numbered. Material quality: I have bought several different editions of this translation, eg. bonded leather, hard cover in different formats. The material quality of the hardcover and leather editions is usually very good, they use to have a lifetime warranty valid for the US so if your bible is worn out you get a new one. Even though I cannot claim it in case, I can confirm from experience having bought quality. What I cannot really recommend is the bonded leather covers as they use to wear out sooner than expected.
